1. Using the New Tab button: Click the New Tab button to open a new blank tab; then type a Web page URL in the Address bar and press Enter or click the Go button to open the page in the new blank tab.

2. Without using the New Tab button: Press the Alt key as you click the Go button to open the page in a new tab.

3. Linked pages: Press the Ctrl key as you click the link to open the linked page in a new tab; alternatively, right-click the link and click Open in New Tab on the shortcut menu.
