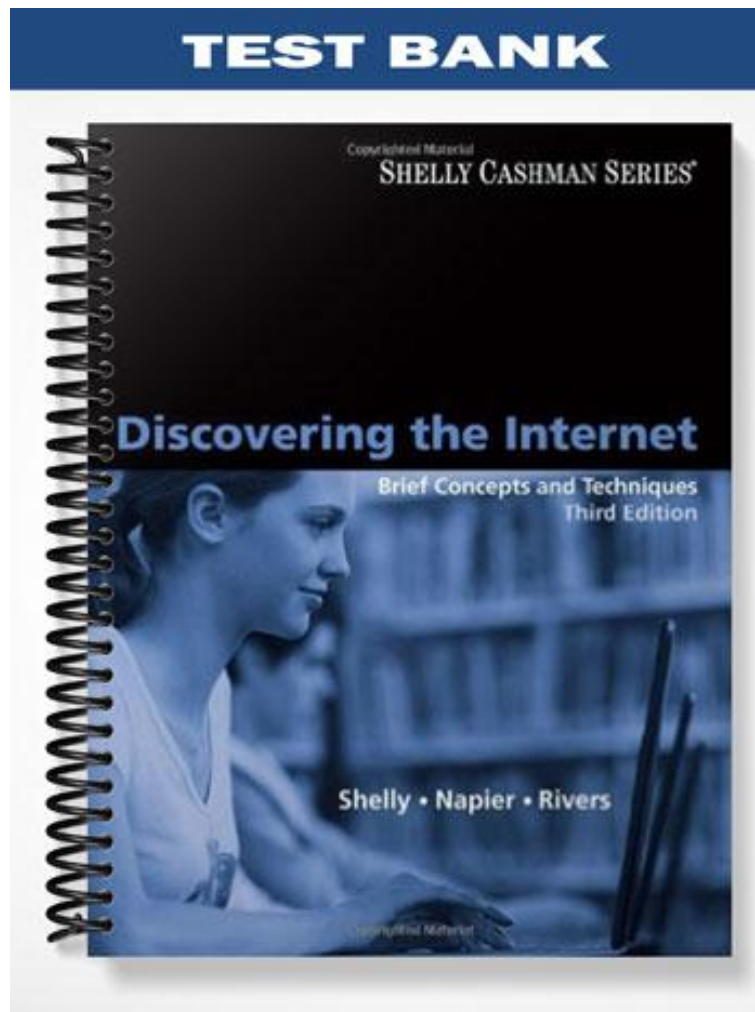

One tab at a time appears in the tab row foreground and the remaining tabs appear in the tab row background. You can click a tab in the background to bring it into the foreground.*

- Using the New Tab button: Click the New Tab button to open a new blank tab; then type a Web page URL in the Address bar and press Enter or click the Go button to open the page in the new blank tab.*

2. Without using the New Tab button: Press the Alt key as you click the Go button to open the page in a new tab.
3. Linked pages: Press the Ctrl key as you click the link to open the linked page in a new tab; alternatively, right-click the link and click Open in New Tab on the shortcut menu.
